



## Tournament Director Agreement

Tournament Directors are responsible for the overall management of accredited tournaments. Responsibilities include, but are not limited to: hiring staff for the event, ensuring timeliness of courts, recording match results, managing issues and resolving conflicts that arise, arranging player gifts, providing food & beverage, and answering any questions that are asked.

When hosting an accredited tournament, a Tournament Director is acting as a representative of US Squash and will conduct himself or herself in a manner that reflects positively on the organization, and provides a fair, positive, and meaningful experience for all participants.

Below is a broad set of expectations intended to guide Tournament Directors in their fulfillment of the role.

I will enforce all policies and guidelines that govern accredited tournament play;

I will uphold the standards outlined in the Tournament Director Code of Conduct;

I will address and intervene in all violations to the US Squash Player Code of Conduct and to the US Squash Parent, Coach, and Attendee Code of Conduct that are observed, or reported at my tournament;

I will report all observed or reported violations to the Code of Conduct to US Squash at the conclusion of my tournament;

I will act as the, or designate a, tournament official who will be responsible for resolving any questions pertaining to the rules of squash;

I will be present and available at all times for the duration of my tournament;

I will apply all rules, policies, and guidelines in an unbiased manner;

I will refrain from and will prohibit my event staff, who are directly involved in the administration of the tournament, from acting in a coaching capacity for the duration of my tournament;

I will work with US Squash through the lifecycle of my tournament;

I will meet the standards outlined in the 'Tournament Expectations Contract.'
