



US Squash Junior Tournament Expectations

Please read the below expectations of running an accredited US Squash junior tournament:

Site Directors: Any person who is managing a tournament venue must meet the criteria of a tournament director. They must be SafeSport Certified and pass the online full club referee exam.

Court Requirements: In order to complete the tournament in the time provided, US Squash requires that the tournament director maintain a ratio of 1 court for every 20 players. Therefore, a 200-player tournament must have 10 courts available throughout the tournament. In rare instances, US Squash may allow tournaments to operate on fewer courts.

Player Gifts: All participants must be provided a player gift at tournament check-in.

Trophies: Trophies must be provided for 1st place, 2nd place, Classic Plate winner, and the Consolation winner. For round robins, only 1st and 2nd place trophies must be provided.

Food and Beverage: Breakfast must be provided on days where matches begin before 10:00am. Lunch must be provided on days where matches are played between 11:00am and 2:00pm.

Current Member Club: All facilities at which matches are played during an accredited tournament must be current US Squash member clubs at the time of the tournament.

Tournament Information Page: The tournament director must periodically update the tabs on the tournament information page with any important event related information. This includes division venue assignments, hotels, venue address, parking instructions, locker room access, practice courts, dress code, and anything other relevant information.

Onsite Tournament Director: The listed tournament director/contact is expected to be US Squash's contact for the tournament and is also expected to be onsite for the duration of the tournament as the person in charge.

Start/End Time: Matches are to begin no earlier than 4:00pm on Friday and end no later than 4:00pm on Sunday. In certain instances, US Squash may allow tournaments to operate outside of these designated hours.
